Certificate III in Individual Support (AIN)

CHC33015 Assistant in Nursing (AIN) – Options to specialize in either Aged Care or Disability. Aspire Training offers this course at either our Cardiff or Maitland Locations. Includes 13 units and 120 hours of clinical placement. Upon completion, you can work in Home and Community Care, Aged Care or Disability Support. We offer regular intakes of the Certificate III in Individual Support. We offer Full-time (3 days/week) or part-time (1 day/week max.) More information and study options can be found on our website.

Certificate IV in Ageing Support

CHC43015 – Similar to the Certificate III in Individual Support as there is a lot of overlapping units with up to 10 of the 18 units can be Credit transfers if you have completed Aspire's Certificate III course. The difference between this and cert III is you can work as a team leader. Course is structured to accommodate those working in the industry so flexible study options are available.

Diploma of Nursing (EN)

HLT54115 Diploma of Nursing. – Enrolled Nurse. Similar job role as an RN although an EN cannot be a team leader they can administer most medications and work in hospital settings. Offered through RTO's including TAFE. Course is generally completed over 18 months (full-time). This course isn't currently offered at Aspire Training, but we are working towards adding it to our scope in future.

Certificate IV in Disability

CHC43115 Certificate 4 in Disability – Focus on the leadership role and includes more responsibilities. Like the examples in "Certificate IV in Ageing Support" there are credit transfer options available. We will be able to offer this course before the end of 2022.

Bachelor of Nursing (RN)

Bachelor of Nursing – upon completion you will be a Registered Nurse. Previous students of our certificate III in Individual Support course who later completed a Bachelor of Nursing found they were better prepared and had much more experience and confidence compared to their peers because they were already working in the industry and had a lot of personal experience. This degree be completed through many Australian University's, generally over three years (full-time). Universities offer alternate entry options if you have completed a Certificate IV or Diploma. For example, you can enrol in the Bachelor of Nursing at University of Newcastle (UoN) after completing a Certificate IV in Ageing Support or Disability. Depending on the selection Rank of that year, a Certificate IV is automatically recognized as Selection Rank 73 (UoN). Experience in the industry is also considered with your application. Other degrees at UoN offer entry if you have completed a Certificate III but information can change so check with the university website. Another example is if you have completed a Diploma of Nursing (EN), you can start at the beginning of second year (UoN) but can vary between different universities.
